The Grievance Redressal Cell (GRC) shall have the following Terms of Reference as per provisions of Statute SSA-7(xiii):

- A. To decide on all election related grievances of the candidates contesting the elections/students participating in the elections.
  - i. It shall serve as the court of original jurisdiction and shall have powers to conduct proceedings and hearing necessary to fulfill the duties assigned to it.
  - ii. It can prosecute violations of any aspect of the code of conduct on the rulings of the GRC.
  - iii. It can summon the candidates students, and request them to give testimony and produce necessary records.
  - iv. It can inspect financial reports of any candidate to check if any code of conduct is violated.
  - v. The members of the GRC are prohibited from filing complaints.
  - vi. It shall act on all complaints within 24 hours after they are received. It is empowered to decide either to dismiss the complaint or call a hearing.
  - vii. The hearing shall be done at the earliest possible time.
- viii. In the case of hearing, the GRC shall ensure that the complaining candidates groups are informed (in writing e-mail) about time and place of hearing and that they are physically present for the hearing.
  - ix. The complaining candidates may be allowed to produce not more than two witnesses.
  - x. There shall be no direct or cross-examination of any party or witnesses by complaining or responding parties during hearings.
  - xi. The GRC shall provide reasonable time limit, fair and equal treatment to both the side. The complaining candidate group shall hear the burden of proof.
- xii. More than half of the members of the GRC present shall constitute the quorum for its meeting.

- xiii. Pending hearing, the GRC by majority opinion, may issue a temporary restraining order to prevent adverse effect on any individual or entity. Such an order will remain in force until a final decision is taken by the GRC. Only bonafide students shall participate in the proceedings/hearings of the GRC. They may receive counsel from bonafide students only.
- xiv. After hearing, if found guilty complaint is genuine, the GRC shall have the power to take appropriate decision/s including disqualification of the candidate/s.
- B. The Vice Chancellor of the University shall be the appellate authority and his/her decision will be final and binding in all cases.

The tenure of the Grievance Redressal Cell (GRC) shall be for one academic year i.e. AY 2025-26.

Each external committee member shall be paid an amount of Rs. 2,000/- per half day sitting and Rs. 4,000/- per full day sitting and T.A. as per rules.
