

### Session I: Book Reading: 'Bilingual Narratives: A Performative Reading' (11:30 – 12:00)

The author himself will start by reading select passages from *The Bitter Fruit Tree and Other Stories* in the original Konkani text, followed by a Bilingual reading in English and Konkani by faculty of Shenoi Goembab School of Languages and Literature. #### Session II: Book Discussion: 'The Trials & Travails of Translation' (12:00 – 1:00 p.m.)
