The objectives of the Program/activity/event	• Equip participants with foundational knowledge of research methodology and its philosophical underpinnings in the humanities. • Develop participants' skills in academic research writing, including proposal development, structuring arguments, and following formal conventions. • Foster critical engagement with feminist theory, particularly concepts like intersectionality, agency, and epistemic power, to enrich research perspectives.
11. Description of the Program/activity/event	This two-day lecture series, led by Dr. Reetu Jaiswal, offered postgraduate students, research scholars, and faculty members a comprehensive introduction to research methodology in the humanities. Day one covered the foundations of research, moving from inquiry to framework, alongside practical guidance on academic writing and proposal development. Day two focused on mastering academic conventions such as citation, formatting, and style, followed by an interactive session exploring feminist theory, intersectionality, and agency. Combining technical skill-building with critical theoretical perspectives, the lecture equipped participants with the tools to conduct ethical, well-structured research while fostering reflexive awareness of their role as knowledge producers

Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	• Participants gained the ability to design ethically sound research projects with clear, researchable questions and well-considered methodological frameworks. • Participants developed the skills to produce academically rigorous writing that is well-structured, precise, and aligned with institutional style guidelines. • Participants learned to apply feminist theoretical frameworks to critique mainstream research paradigms and situate their own scholarly work within broader socio-political contexts.
