Description of the activity	The Discipline of French and Francophone Studies at the Shenoi Goembab School of Languages and Literafure, Goa University, organised a guest lecture to commemorate India's Independence Day. The lecture held on August 06, 2025, examined the writings of Libyan-American poet, Khaled Mattawa and Indo-Mauritian author Ananda Devi through a thought-provoking analysis of their verse.  Prof. Brinda Mehta eloquently discussed the Mediterranean as a "necro-geography" and explored the metaphor of "burning" as a central theme, connecting irregular migration, ecological crisis, surveillance technology, and the poets' passionate call for justice. The lecture concluded with a dynamic question-and-answer session, where participants exchanged with the resource person on migration linked themes as seen in the poetry. The event was coordinated by Dr. Irene Silveira.
