Goa Water Stories Fellowship 2025-26

This fellowship seeks students whose dissertations are connected to Goa, water and ecology, and who are interested in expanding their academic work through a **transdisciplinary framework** and developing **creative**, **public-facing narratives**. Over a period of **six months**, selected fellows will receive mentoring, participate in skill-building workshops, and collaborate across disciplines to contribute to an evolving archive of Goa's water heritage.

Fellows will gain hands-on experience in research and documentation methodologies, multimedia storytelling and community engagement, learning how to translate academic insights into accessible knowledge. They will learn and use creative tools such as text, image, audio, video and data visualisation, while also engaging in peer learning and interdisciplinary exchange. This process will not only enrich their dissertations but also strengthen their research capacity, professional networks and practical skills—valuable assets for future careers in academia, policy, advocacy, media, environment and cultural practice.

Through this initiative, fellows will explore themes such as the Western Ghats and the monsoon water cycle, rivers and water bodies, wells and tanks, *khazans*, and the coastal ecosystem. The fellowship aims to amplify local voices, deepen ecological scholarship, and foster public dialogue on water, climate change, livelihoods and conservation.
