Description of the Event	<p>As part of Rural Camp 2025, students visited the Anganwadi at Char Rasta, Canacona, where they interacted with both Anganwadi workers and young children to gain practical insights into early childhood care and development.</p> <p>Anganwadi Visit Highlights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understanding Child Development – Anganwadi workers shared insights into nutrition, health monitoring, and preschool education provided under the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme. • Observing Daily Practices – Students observed growth tracking, meal distribution, and early learning sessions at the center. • Community Challenges – Discussions were held on access to healthcare, parental awareness, and gaps in early education. • Creative Engagement Activities: Students conducted fun-filled, interactive sessions for children, fostering self-expression and creativity through: <p>The children participated with great enthusiasm, and Anganwadi workers appreciated the initiative, emphasizing the importance of creative learning in early childhood development.</p>

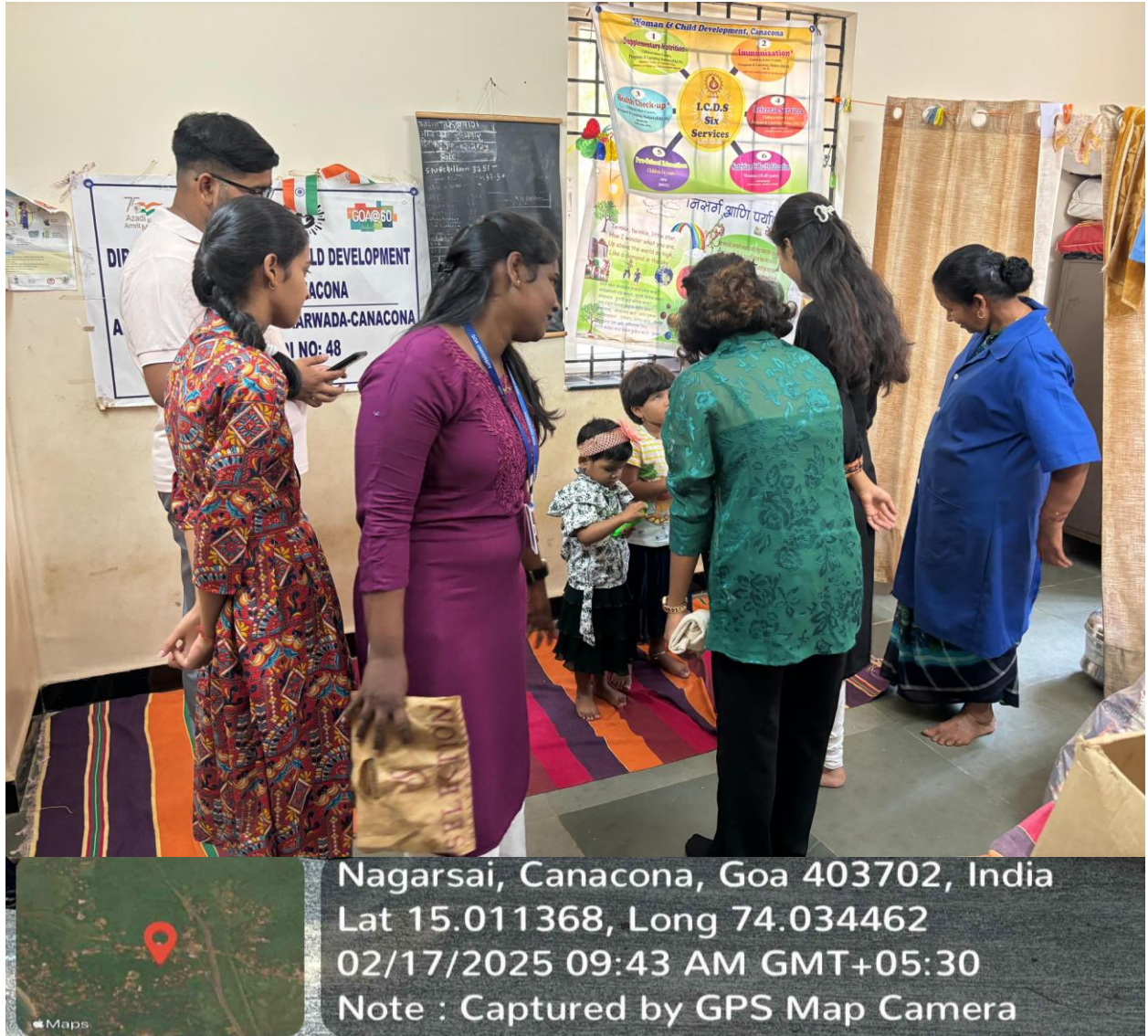
