To encourage active participation in local waste management initiatives. 11. Description of the The Door-to-Door Awareness Campaign on Waste Event Segregation at Cotigao Panchayat was an initiative to engage directly with the local community and promote sustainable waste management practices. A total of **36 households** were visited by students, who conducted informal discussions with residents about: • The difference between wet and dry waste and why segregation is crucial. • The impact of improper waste disposal on health and the environment. Simple, practical steps for effective waste management at home. To enhance the effectiveness of the campaign, students designed and distributed educational flyers, visually demonstrating proper waste segregation techniques and sustainable waste disposal methods. The response from the community was highly positive, with many residents expressing their willingness to adopt better waste disposal habits. Some even requested more awareness initiatives on environmental sustainability. 12.
