With social media playing a significant role in students' lives, the session aimed to highlight safe online practices and digital well-being.</p> <p>Through engaging dramatization and real-life examples, the play covered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dangers of cyberbullying and its impact on mental health. • Online scams, identity theft, and data privacy concerns. • How to use social media safely, avoid fake profiles, and prevent cyber threats. <p>The performance was followed by an interactive Q&A session, where students shared their experiences and raised questions about protecting themselves in the digital space. The school staff and faculty appreciated the initiative, emphasizing the need for continued digital literacy efforts.</p>
