6. Detail of the Resource Person (Brief biodata)	Ms. Sudiksha S. Naik, a seasoned Police Inspector, currently serves at the Anti-Human Trafficking Unit, Margao, and the Women & Child Protection Unit, Margao. A dedicated law enforcement officer, she has been at the forefront of crime prevention, women's safety, and child protection for over two decades. With a strong academic foundation in Organic Chemistry (BSc & MSc), Ms. Naik joined the Goa Police in 2002 as a Police Sub-Inspector. Over the	

	years, she has served in Panaji Police Station, Crime Branch, Margao Town Police Station, Women & Child Protection Unit, and Dabolim Airport Immigration, before being promoted to Police Inspector in 2013. Her tenure as In-charge of the Women Police Station, Panaji (2015–2022) and Anti-Human Trafficking Unit, Margao (since 2022) has been marked by numerous successful investigations, securing convictions in crimes against women and children. She has led raids, rescued trafficking victims, and spearheaded multiple state-level initiatives for stakeholder training and awareness. A sought-after resource person in colleges, schools, and police training programs, she has conducted two State-Level Conferences on Human Trafficking and six specialized training programs on women's safety for law enforcement. Her dedication has earned her commendation certificates, the Swabhimaan Award, and recognition from the Rotary Club of Miramar, Amodini
	Foundation, and various NGOs, solidifying her reputation as a tireless advocate for justice and empowerment.

10. Objectives of the Event	 To educate participants on legal frameworks and protection mechanisms related to women's and children's safety. To raise awareness on advocacy strategies and

	rights-based approaches for community empowerment. To discuss the role of parents in child protection and online safety. To encourage reporting of domestic violence for effective intervention and support.			
11. Description of the Event	The interactive workshop, held at Panchayat Hall, Cotigao, focused on women's and children's safety, rights, and protection mechanisms in collaboration with the Cotigao Panchayat.			
	Ms. Sudiksha Naik, the resource person, covered various aspects of the Domestic Violence Act, 2005, emphasizing the need to report violence either at the police station or to the Block Development Officer for timely intervention. She urged women to be brave and strong, rather than allow violence to be normalized in society.			
	She also shed light on child abuse and online safety, stressing the critical role of parents in addressing abuse while ensuring children's rights are protected. On the occasion, the Sarpanch and Panch Member of Cotigao also spoke, reinforcing the importance of legal awareness and community action in ensuring safety and justice.			
	The session concluded with an engaging Q&A discussion, where women shared their experiences and gained clarity on legal rights, reporting mechanisms, and support systems available.
