The objectives of the Program/activity/event Objective (50-100 words)	The primary objective of the workshop was to promote academic integrity and research best practices among faculty, researchers, and students. It aimed to familiarize participants with UGC and AICTE guidelines on plagiarism, provide hands-on exposure to plagiarism and AI-text detection tools like DrillBit, and highlight the importance of ethical research practices. The program also sought to strengthen institutional capacity by enabling educators and administrators to implement effective policies, improve the quality of scholarly outputs, and contribute to a culture of originality and authenticity in higher education.
11. Description of the 100 words Program/activity/event	The one-day workshop at Goa University was jointly organized with DrillBit Softech Pvt. Ltd. The event featured expert sessions on academic integrity, the ShodhShuddhi programme, and UGC-AICTE initiatives, followed by interactive demonstrations of plagiarism detection and AI-text analysis. Participants, including faculty, research scholars, and administrators, engaged in

	discussions, hands-on activities, and Q&A sessions to understand practical applications of plagiarism tools in academia. The workshop was designed to provide actionable knowledge and technical training that institution could integrate into their academic and research workflows to ensure compliance with national standards.

Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event 50-100 words	The workshop helped participants gain a deeper understanding of plagiarism policies, research ethics, and the use of advanced detection technologies. Faculty and researchers learned how to evaluate academic work more effectively, while administrators were better equipped to implement institutional research integrity frameworks. Key outcomes included improved awareness of ethical writing, enhanced ability to detect and prevent academic misconduct, and readiness to integrate plagiarism detection tools within institutional systems. Ultimately, the program contributed to raising the quality of research and publications emerging from Goa University and its affiliated institutions.
