Description of the Program/activity/event	Dr. Sulochana Pednekar , Nodal officer of Women Cell , introduced the objective of the event and welcomed the Chief Guest , Prof. Suder Dhuri, Registrar, Goa University , Prof. Nagendra Rao, Dean, DDKSSBS, Dr. Norma Rebello , Director DEO , NSS Programme Officer ,Shri Vinod Kankonkar and the Resource Persons – Ms. Mamtha Mallik and Ms. Yukta Kumbhar – Counsellors and trainers at Cyber Wellness centre . Dr. Norma Rebello, Director, DEO presented the flower bouque to all the invited dignitaries on the dais. Prof. Dean , addressed the gathering by sharing insights from his personal life and informed the students to benefit from this lecture. Ms. Mamtha Mallik briefly informed the gathering about Cyber Wellness Centre and their interest in forming a cyber cell at Goa University.
