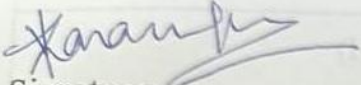
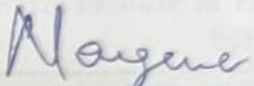

Image2- During discussion session

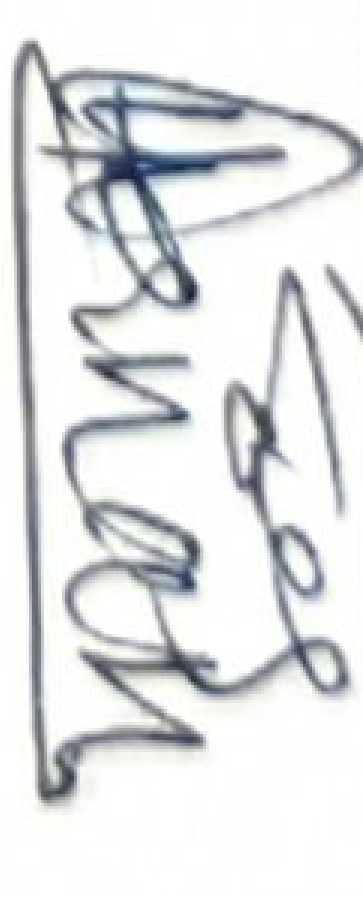

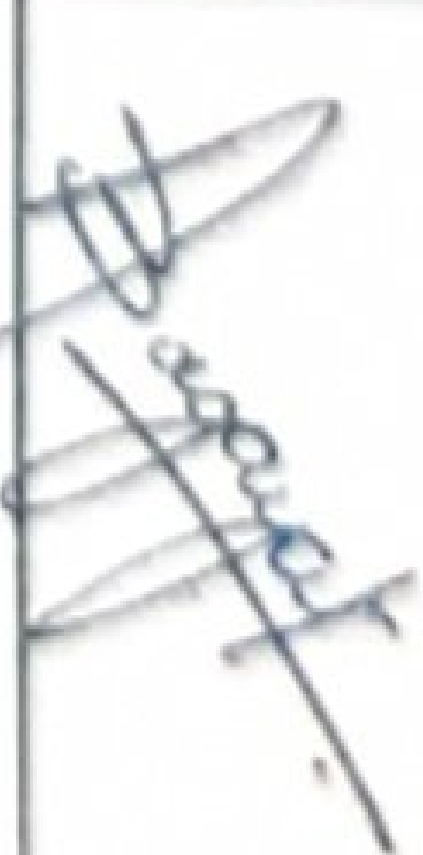

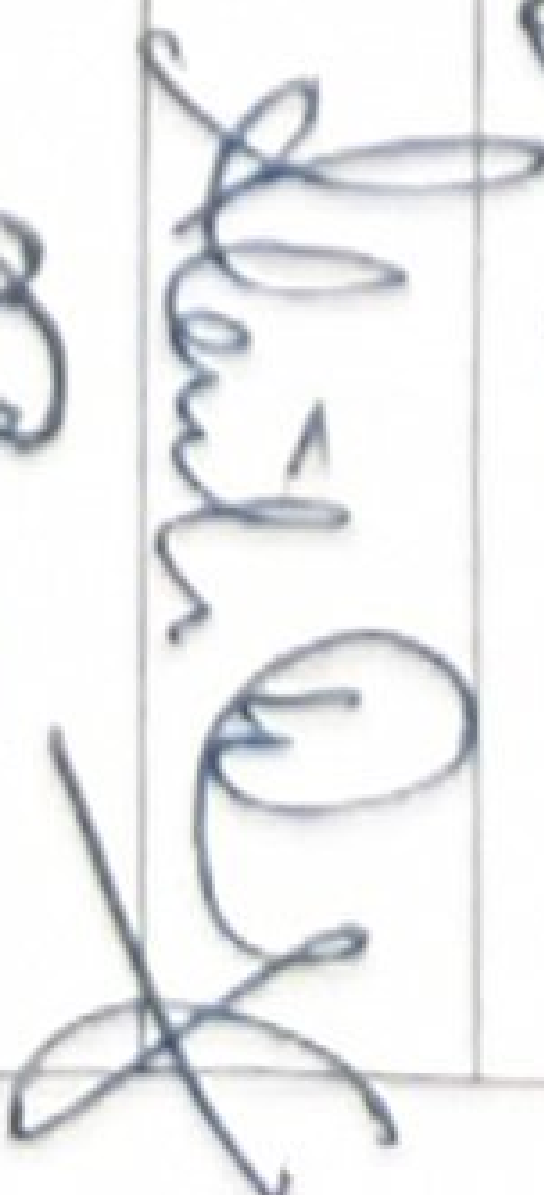
