10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	This field trip is organized as a part of the Gender, Environment and Ecology and Doing Feminist Research Course. To provide the

students opportunity to connect theory to the local context and field realities. Also, to provide opportunities for students to interact and understand the lifestyle, livelihood, culture and to understand the day today challenges faced by the community living in Mhadei Wildlife Sanctuary, Goa.

11. Description of the Program/activity/event

On 10 October 2025, on the way the team Aamche Daaiz Museum at Keri, visited Sattari, Goa which has showcased the Folklife and traditional materials used in Goa having cultural significance too. Students got an insight into things and materials used by local people in their day to day life in olden days. The team proceeded to Vivekanand Dnyan Mandir School located in Goteli No.1 Keri, in Sattari taluka. At 3.30 p.m. Pournima Kerkar provided an insight into local culture and difficulties faced by women as well as people living in Mhadei Wildlife Sanctuary. After that team visited a Shri Parvadeshwar madth, Bailowado, Keri sattari and interacted with Fugdi group of Shri Parvadeshwar Mahila Mandal where a group of women taking part in performing fugdi interacted with the students and how through songs gender issues are communicated was discussed. The team was briefed about the group by Shri Gopinath Gawas. Besides team also interacted with another group of Women belonging to Shri Belevansh Fugdi Mahila Mandal who also perform dhalo/fugdi in various competitions. Next day team visited Ajoba temple and sati temple and Shri Gopinath Gawas narrated the story behind the temple and rituals. Team visited the Rural Medical Dispensary and Doctor explained the students about the facilities provided at the dispensary and presence of sub-health centre too functioning Team visited the Forest simultaneously. Nursery where few students were provided plants to take away for planting. On 11th October from 12.00 p.m. to 1.00 p.m. Students and teachers conducted outreach activities with students from Grade VII to Xth Grade. 6 outreach sessions were conducted during the field trip – creating awareness about pollution, saving trees, waste management and gender sensitization and

	presented prizes to students for taking part in the activities. Team thanked the School and support staff for hosting the students and facilitating the logistic arrangements. Students to present their experiences and learning's as a presentation and submit report related to outreach activities on 24 October 2025.
12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	Students got deeper understanding of the problems and challenges faced by women and their involvement in preserving the traditional culture witnessed the struggles and challenges faced by women in their day to day life. From Mrs Pournima Kerkar's lecture students learnt that there is scope for research in understanding folk culture and also gender issues in Goa.
