# Institutional Visit Report of Reva University, Bangalore

On November 7, 2025, a group of 35 students, accompanied by four faculty members from Reva University, Bengaluru, visited the School of Chemical Sciences (SCS) at Goa University during the first half of the day. The students were from the third semester of the Master's Degree Program with different branches of specialisation in Chemistry. The group also consisted of a couple of research scholars and a lab instructor.

Ms Siddhali V. Girkar, Chairperson (SCS visit committee), coordinated the institutional visit to SCS. Along with her, the committee members, Dr Amrita Kharangate, Mr Saurav Sattarker, and Dr Amrita Vetrekar, presented the facilities at SCS, as well as the programs and activities that are conducted. Most of the research scholars from the chemistry and biochemistry disciplines actively showcased various facilities, including cyclic voltammetry, HPLC, thermogravimetric analysis (TG), CHNS analysis, X-ray diffraction (XRD), nuclear magnetic resonance (NMR), UV-visible photoluminescence, infrared spectroscopy (IR), laminar air flow, cooling centrifuges, and incubator shakers, to the visiting students. Mr Pranav Volvoikar helped capture geotagged images during the visit. Dr Luann D'Souza and Mrs Ankita Desai coordinated the event and explained the laboratory facilities available in the MSc lab and the other research labs.

The students and the accompanying faculty members were incredibly impressed with the facilities available at SCS, Goa University and have expressed their desire for further research collaborations with the talented faculty members.
