The Prime Minister outlined India's Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047, emphasizing port efficiency, massive infrastructure investments, and a push towards green shipping. The overall IMW event was presided over and concluded by the Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Shri Sarbananda Sonowal.
