Objective of the Activity	To carry out a cleanliness drive in the area around Dharbandora Panchayat junction to create a sense of responsibility among students to maintain cleanliness and plastic free environment.
Description of the Activity	<p>As a part of Extension and Outreach program, the events committee of School of Chemical Sciences, Goa University organized cleanliness drive at Dharbandora Panchayat junction with the involvement of SCS faculties and MSc Part-I and Part-II students on 3rd January 2025. The event started at 11.00 am in the presence of Mr. Vinayak Gauns, Sarpanch, Village Panchayat - Dharbandora. He appreciated the efforts of the school in organizing such outreach activities. Dr. Bidhan Shinkre emphasised on the importance and need of outreach activities such as Cleanliness drives. The cleanliness accessories such as gloves, garbage bags and sticks were provided to the participants by Goa University. 


