She is the founder of the amateur theatre group Mustard Seed Art Company in Goa and has written and directed over 65 theatre productions. With more than 40 years of teaching experience, Prof. Vás holds a PhD from Goa University, specialising in drama, British and American literature. Her doctoral thesis, Performing Change: Theatre in the Context of Social Transformation in Three Asian Cultures in the Twentieth Century, reflects her interest in theatre as a medium for social reflection and change.

Description of the Program/activity/event	The Discipline of English organised a theatrical performance titled <i>Tongue-Tied: A Docudrama</i> , directed by Prof. Isabel Santa Rita Vás, a distinguished playwright, theatre director, and educator from Goa. The performance explored themes of language, identity, and multilingualism, highlighting the social and cultural significance of respecting linguistic diversity. Staged by the Mustard Seed Art Company, a renowned English theatre group in Goa with over three decades of experience in socially relevant theatre, the play underscored the vital role language plays in everyday life. Notably, students from the Discipline of English were part of the cast, offering them valuable experiential learning and practical exposure to theatre and performance studies. The performance attracted a large audience and successfully sensitised viewers to the prevalence and value of multilingualism in contemporary society.


