7. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The objective of the tour was to provide students with practical exposure to the functioning of financial markets and monetary systems through visits to the RBI Monetary Museum, NCDEX, and BSE. The tour aimed to enhance students' understanding of market operations, regulatory frameworks, commodity and securities trading mechanisms, and the role of central banking. It also sought to bridge the gap between theory and practice while fostering industry-academia interaction to support future career opportunities through internships and placements.

8. Description of the Program/activity/event	The Financial Services discipline of Goa Business School organized an Industrial Tour to Mumbai from 27th to 30th January 2026. A total of 30 students and three faculty members participated in the tour. The institutions visited included the National Commodity & Derivatives Exchange Limited (NCDEX), the RBI Monetary Museum, and the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE). The tour provided students with insights into the functioning of agricultural commodity derivatives, the securities trading framework, and the evolution of currency and the monetary functions of the Reserve Bank of India.
9. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	The industrial tour enabled students to gain first-hand exposure to key financial institutions and market infrastructure in India. The visit to the RBI Monetary Museum enhanced students' understanding of the evolution of currency, monetary policy, and the role of the Reserve Bank of India in maintaining financial stability. At NCDEX, students gained insights into the functioning of agricultural commodity derivatives, price discovery, risk management, and the role of commodity exchanges in supporting farmers and agribusinesses. Students gained visual exposure to the historic Bombay Stock Exchange during the industrial tour. Overall, the tour helped bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world market practices, thereby improving students' industry awareness and career readiness




