<p><b>11. Description of the Event</b></p>	<p>The Anganwadi visit was conducted as part of Rural Camp 2025 to provide students with practical exposure to community-based early childhood care and development services. The session focused on understanding the childcare, nutrition, and early learning support provided at the Anganwadi level, with particular emphasis on play-based learning approaches that promote children’s physical, cognitive, emotional, and social development.</p> <p>Students organized interactive activities designed to engage children in a joyful learning environment. One of the main activities conducted was <i>Passing the Parcel</i>, where children were encouraged to recite poems, dance, or introduce themselves according to their comfort level. This activity helped build confidence, communication skills, and self-expression among participants. Small gifts were distributed as positive reinforcement, which further motivated active participation.</p> <p>An additional component of the visit focused on health and hygiene education. Using a visual poster as a teaching aid, students demonstrated correct handwashing and oral hygiene practices through role-play and action-based instruction. The session was conducted bilingually in English and Hindi under the theme “Hand Washing and Toilet Practice.” Children actively followed the demonstrations while caregivers and Anganwadi workers provided support and supervision.</p>



It strengthened students' understanding of grassroots child development programmes, preventive health education, and the functioning of community-level service delivery systems.
