Prof. Poorwa Naik. This was followed by a brief self-introduction by all faculty members of the Discipline of English, SGSLL.</p> <p>Subsequently, Asst. Prof. Poorwa Naik addressed the visiting students, providing an overview of the nature of research undertaken within the discipline, the courses offered under the M.A. English programme, and the academic and research scope available to postgraduate students. This session offered valuable insights into the curriculum and research culture of the discipline.</p> <p>The research scholars of the discipline then spoke about their respective research areas, highlighting ongoing work and emerging areas of study. This interaction offered the visiting students and faculty a clear understanding of the diverse research engagements within the discipline.
