Exploring the 'Public' in Public Services and 'Civilian' in Civil Services

Public Administration Program of Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy (MPSLGPP), Goa University organized its second session of the Invited Guest Lecture Series 'Publico II' on 15th October 2024 from 11.30 am to 1.30 pm at Block G, MPSLGPP, Goa University. The session was organized to celebrate the birth anniversary of the 11th President of India, Late. Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, also known as the People's President. The day is also marked as the 'World Students Day'. The lecture titled '*Exploring the 'Public' in Public Services and 'Civilians' in Civil Services*' was delivered by Ms. Diksha Namdev Tari (Junior Scale Officer at Goa Civil Services). The session began with the welcome address and presentation of the potted plant by Dr. Steffi Quintal, Assistant Professor in the Public Administration program, to the resource person.

Ms. Diksha Namdev Tari, in her interactive lecture, highlighted the various opportunities available to students in public/civil services. 


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
