PREFACE

I have great pleasure in presenting the Twelfth Annual Report of Goa University for the academic year 1996-97. The report is presented in six parts. Part 1 deals with the "General Administration", Part 2 with Authorities of the University, Part 3 with Departments on the University Campus, Part 4 with Affiliated Colleges both professional and non-professional, Part 5 with Recognized Institutions and Part 6 provides the Financial Statement.

The Report has been compiled by the University on the basis of information provided by the various administrative sections, teaching departments, colleges and reconigzed institutions. It has been our experience that the process of collecting information from the various sources has been both difficult and time consuming. This has often lead to delay in finalisation of the Report. I hope that in future there will be prompt response from all concerned.

The academic year has seen considerable change in the academic climate, both on the campus and in the affiliated institutions. The stress and strain of implementation of restructured course at the undergraduate level have subsided due to close cooperation of all constituents of the University. There has been all round development and consolidation in teaching and research, both at the undergraduate and post-graduate levels. All out efforts have been made to provide infrastructural facilities to encourage research.

I place on record my deep sense of gratitude to the Visitor for the keen interest he has shown in the functioning of the University to such an extent that he visited the Campus on a number of occasions and interacted with the faculty. I am extremely grateful to the State Government for all the encouragement and continued support in the implementation of the objectives of the University. I also place on record my sincere thanks to members of Court, Academic Council, Executive Council and other bodies of the University. My grateful thanks are also due to all the members of teaching and non-teaching staff of the University for making 1996-97 yet another successful year.

PART 1: GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

- 1.1 General Information: Goa University was established on 1 June, 1985 as a affiliating-cumteaching University. It has completed eleven years of its existence. The University had inherited educational structure of University of Bombay to which all institutions of higher learning were affiliated since the days of Goa's liberation in 1961. Post-graduate education was imparted by the Centre of Post-Graduate Instruction and Research, which formed the nucleus of Goa University. At present Goa University has infrastructure to impart education in faculties of Languages, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Life Sciences, Commerce, Management, Medicine, Engineering and Fine Arts. The University offers graduate and post-graduate programmes in Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Home Science, Education, Law, Engineering, Pharmacy, Medicine including Ayurveda. Fine Arts, Music and Architecture. There are in all 22 University Departments, 2 University Centres, 1 U.G.C. financed institution (Academic Staff College), 35 affiliated colleges (both professional and non-professional) and 8 recognized institutions conducting research. Since 1990 the University has been functioning from its own campus situated at Taleigao plateau.
- **1.2 Engineering Projects:** The University Works Division handled major infrastructure projects during the year for smooth functioning of University. Apart from that the division also maintained the existing infrastructure efficiently. Standby generator commissioned to provide continuous power supply needed for research and teaching activities. The following works are in advance stage of completion:
- 1. Construction of 200 bedded Girls Hostel: The work order was issued to M/s Premier Builders on 31.12.1996 for an amount of Rs 1,93,31,831.00. Stipulated date of completion of work is 04.07.1998. Upto 31.12.1997 work done is Rs. 82,58,044.31. Physical progress of work is 60%. **The work** is expected to get completed in all **respect before** new academic year begins.
- 2. Construction of 15 Nos. A type quarters: The work order was issued to M/s M.S. Harmalkar on 31.12.1996 for an amount of Rs. 1,28,47,551.00. Stipulated date of completion of work is 03.07.1998. Upto 31.12.1997 work done is of Rs. 64,86,314.00. Physical progress of work is 80%. The work is **expected to get completed in all** respects by 30.04.1998.
- 3. Construction of 25 Nos. B type Quarters: The work order was issued to Mis P.P.C. Constructions on 31.12.1996 for Rs. 1,89,25,340.00. Stipulated date of completion on this work is 03.07.1998. Upto 31.12.1997 amount of work done is Rs. 72,43,846.00. Physical progress of work is 75%. The work is expected to be **completed in all respects** by 30.06.1998.
- 4. Construction of Faculty Building for MMS: The work was awarded in November, 1996. The building work is nearly completion stage and expected to be completed in all respects by 28.02.1998.

Besides these major works, the University Works Division has done Re-proofing of Vice-Chancellor's and Registrar's Bungalows and one wing of Guest House. The sanction is also obtained for U.G.C. funded building for centre for Latin American Studies. The work has already commenced.

1.3 Computerisation of University Functions: The Computer Centre was entrusted with the voluminous work relating to the F.Y. & S.Y. examinations of B.A., B.Sc. and <u>B.Com</u>. Preprocessing/Result processing work was successfully handled in addition to routine examination work.

The basic computer training was given to two more batches of the Administrative staff and officers. Besides, Shri Sanjay Bandodkar, Programmer was sent to Japan for Client Server Application System Development training at the invitation Centre of the International Co-operation for Computerisation, Japan.

1.4 Conduct of Examinations: The University has conducted 33 under-graduate examinations in various faculties during the first and second half of 1996-97. 6902 students appeared for the examinations, and out of these, 4403 were declared successful.

The University has conducted 80 post-graduate examinations. 966 students appeared, and out of these, 583 students were declared successful.

The University awarded 13 Pli.D degrees and 20 M.Phil degrees in different subjects during the period June, 1996 to May, 1997.

- **1.5** University Library: The Goa University Library started functioning as University Library from 30th June, 1985. The Library of the Centre of Post-graduate Instruction and Research, University of Bombay, which was established in 1965 and having a collection of 37678 books and periodicals, was incorporated into Goa University and forms the base of the Goa University Library. The Library has a total of 80700 books in all disciplines. The University Library has a separate journal section and more than 480 journals are subscribed to, while some journals are received as *gratis*. The University Library also consists of theses and several dissertations. The Goa University rare collections have further enriched the University corpus by addition of collection from:
- 1. A collection of about 189 books and Journals from Mr. Rui D'Cruz.
- 2. A collection of books in Mathematics by Prof. B.V. Singbal.
- 3. A collection of about 179 books from Shri P.M. Arunan.
- 4. A collection of about 233 books, journals and magazines donated by Prof. B.S. Sonde.
- 5. A collection of about 168 books donated by Shri Erasmo De Sequeira
- 6. A collection of about 583 books donated by Dr. V.B. Prabhudessai

The library also includes 170 books specially of Latin American Studies ion the USIS collection The library also receive books from the World Health Organisation, Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute, New Delhi and USIS regularly. More over recently it has been declared a U.N. Depository Library.

Once the application of computers in the Library operation is completed, readers will have easy and quick access to documents in the Library. Presently, the Library's collection is already on computer and reference and bibliographic services are made available to the readers. The library has also acquired a PC under INFLIBNET programme. With the INTERNET facility on the campus, the library has also been identified under the INFLIBNET Programme.

1.6 Students' Sports Activities: The Sports Department of the Goa University has completed a decade in the organisation of Inter-collegiate tournament, Inter-University participation and organisation of summer coaching camp etc.

At the end of every tournament a special function was held in an auspicious manner and given trophies, medals and certificates to the winners/runners-up. The result of different competitions held during the year 1996-97 as follows:

- 1.7 Student's Welfare and Cultural Activities: Directorate of Students' Welfare & Cultural Affairs under the change of Director, Dr. T.D.Halarnakar undertakes curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities of the students of Goa University and thereby creates opportunity to the students to develop their talents in various fields of Arts and Culture viz. Music, dance, dramatics, literature, fine art, debates etc. The Directorate also encourages the students to undertake the social activities, in order to enable them to translate their knowledge into practical utility. The Directorate organised the following activities:

- **1.8** Academic Staff College: The Academic Staff Orientation Scheme (ASOS) has been sponsored by the University Grants Commission under the National Policy on Education, 1986 (NPE). The NPE recognises the need for improving the status of teachers and proposes to provide opportunities for professional and career development.

The intention of the University Grants Commission in sponsoring the ASOS and the establishment of Academic Staff Colleges in 48 Universities in the Country is to bring about qualitative improvement in higher education. The objective of the course is clear to strengthen the teacher's motivation and attitudes in his/her excellence.

The ASC at Goa University conducts Orientation courses for newly appointed teachers and Refresher courses in the specific subjects allotted to the ASC by the University Grants Commission.

During the year 1996-97 the Academic Staff College conducted four Orientation Courses and Refresher Courses in Chemistry, Life Sciences, Physics, Need-based Interdisciplinary Refresher Course in the faculty of Languages, and Need-based Refresher Course in Education.

Department conducted research on (a) electoral politics in Goa (b) Panchayati Raj Institutions in Goa (c) Media's response to liberation of Goa and (d) State's response to developmental issues in Goa. Department of Chemistry

Preparation, synthesis and characterization of ternary compounds either by ceramic method or precipitation method having superconducting properties.

Synthesis, characterization and study of physical properties of mixed transition metal chalcogenides in vaccum of the order of 10⁻⁶min of Hg. The renewed interest in this field has arisen because of abnormal properties exhibited by them.

Catalytic Amination of t-Butyl alcohol over modified ZSM-5 catalysts.

Enrichment of low grade ores.

Natural products, identification of medicinal active plants and their bio-degradation.

Isolation & characterization of bio-active compounds from medicinal plants.

Synthesis of bio-active natural products.

Development of Charge models for the study of intermolecular interactions.

Department of Computer Science and Technology

Graaph algorithms, object oriented concepts, Data mining, data warehousing, application of Compiler optimisation technique in solving y2k problem, capturing casulty events in distributed computing, motion control in Computer amination, Computer aided geometric design, Virtual reality, Measurement of software complexity, routing and security related areass of computer networks.

Department of Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics has been engaged in research broadly in both pure Mathematics and Mathematical Physics. During the year under considerations the department continued investigating the

properties of Measurable Bundle of Operator Algebras supporting a group action with a view to understand the behavior of Quantum Spin Glasses. The entire structure has been worked out and will form a part of a Ph.D. thesis. The departmental interest in Topology has been centered around problems in Knot Theory and its relation to other branches of Analysis and Operator Algebras. There has been some progress achieved in the study of ordinary differential equations with piece-wise continuous deviating arguments. The theory of Elliptic Partial Differential Equations with non-linearities is also being actively investigated. One area in Mathematical Physics which research has been initiated is the inverse spectral problem of Schroendinger Operators. Due to the very nature of the problem being investigated progress is slow as expected.

Department of Physics

Electical and structural properties of thallium based 123 superconducting oxides have been studied using XANES and EXAFS. It has been shown that in these materials the trivalent thallium ions play an important role and that L I absorption rather that L III is useful in characterization of valence states of thallium in these superconducting oxides Tc of the order of 125 K.

Magnetic inelastic neutron scattering studies have been carried out at BARC, Bombay at very low temperatures on various cerium intermetallics in order to examine the magnetic excitations and crystal field effects.

The structures of nuclear waste glasses have been examined by neutron and X-ray diffraction. In order to understand the role of heavy elements in these glasses, a series of rare-earth oxides in an alternative host of phosphorous pentoxide has been prepared. Initial characterization by X-rays has been made but a more complete understanding awaits neutron diffraction, magnetic susceptibility, dielectric and other measurements.

Use of the density matrix renormalization group to study the quantum transition that occurs in the half filled one dimentional fermionic Hubbard model with onsite potential disorder has been made.

Monte Carlo simulation of neutron scattering of glasses

Thermoluminescence studies of high Tc superconducting studies.

Preparation of porous silicon by irradiating different samples of amorphous silicon with high energy Ag ion is being carried out.

Seting up and commissioning a campus wide local network connecting the three faculty blocks

University Science Instrumentation Centre

The Centre is engaged in research and developmental activities in the areas like biomedical tranducers, instruments and opto-electronics. The Centre has already developed instrumentation for Zoology Department for stimulation of nervous systems. Work is in progress to develop full experimental set-up for stimulation of nervous systems at different potentials and intervals and also to measure the reaction of nervous systems.




