D 3.1	Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Skill Enhancement Courses through circulation on 07.09.2020. The Standing Committee of the Academic Council after discussion did not approve the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Skill Enhancement Courses. It was decided to refer the minutes back to the Board of Studies with the following observations:		
	 The heading of the annexure to read as Syllabus instead of Ordinance. Name of the Institution not to be mentioned on the syllabus. The title of the Course/Paper on Environment and Public Health to be reviewed. The Revised syllabus of B.Sc. Fashion and Apparel Design and B.Sc. Interior Design was not approved as the Board had not justified the revision within two years of starting the Programmes. The House was of the view that the approved syllabus should be operational for at least three years. It was resolved that the B.Sc. Interior Design Programme should come within the purview of the Board of Studies in Planning and Design with the suggestion that changes required in the syllabus are to be notified under New Special Ordinance OS-1. The Chairperson, Board of Studies was requested to submit a separate note to the University for consideration. The members wished to know how the Practical were being conducted by the college and requested the Registrar to have a meeting with the Principal in this regard.

D 5 STATUTES AND ORDINANCES

Proposed part amendment to Ordinance OC-33A relating to Choice Based Credit Post-Graduate Degree Programme, Master of Law – LL.M. in Goa University Affiliated Colleges (Applicable for candidates who register from the academic year 2016-17 onwards).

The Standing Committee of the Academic Council noted the decision of the Academic Council in its meeting held on 23rd, 24th and 27th July 2020 and approved the Proposed part amendment to Ordinance OC-33A relating to Choice Based Credit Post-Graduate Degree Programme, Master of Law – LL.M. in Goa University Affiliated Colleges.

It was also decided to place the proposed amendment before the next meeting of the Executive Council.

D 5.2 Proposed part amendment to the following Ordinances

- 1. Ordinances OC-34A relating to the Integrated Five Year Double Degree Programme in Law Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws (B.A.LL.B) and/or Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Laws (B.Com. LL.B).
- 2. Ordinances OC-35A relating to Three Year LL.B Degree Programme in Law.

The Standing Committee of the Academic Council noted the decision of the Academic Council in its meeting held on 23rd, 24th and 27th July 2020 and approved the Proposed part amendment to Ordinances OC-34A and Ordinances OC-35A.

D 5.3 SB-XX: New Statute related to appointment /recognition of Adjunct Faculty

The Academic Council was informed that the New Statute SB-XX was approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 11th, 15th and 18th May, 2018 and the Executive Council in its meeting held on 15th March, 2019.

After discussion, it was decided to carry out the following changes to the Statute to make recognized Ph.D Guides of Affiliated Colleges eligible to be appointed/recognized as Adjunct Faculty:

SB-XX.2 Eligibility

All the recognised Ph.D. guides from recognised Research Centres, Research Institutes and Affiliated Colleges who have a minimum of two publications in SCOPUS and/or Web of Science list of journals. This condition is not applicable to the recognised Ph.D. guides in the Field of Indian Languages and Literature.

SB-XX.3 Appointment

Executive Council shall make these appointments on the recommendations of any of the following:

- (a) Department Council of the Concerned Department, Dean of the Faculty and Vice-Chancellor
- (b) School Board of the concerned School, Dean of the School and Vice-Chancellor
- (c) Faculty Board of the Concerned Faculty and Vice-Chancellor
- (d) Vice Chancellor

It was decided to refer the matter to the State Government for their concurrence and subsequently to the Executive Council for approval and Honourable Chancellor for his assent.

D 7 OTHER ITEMS

D 7.1 To consider the proposal for review of the Processing Fee/Payment of Honorarium for applying for Recognition as PG Teacher/Ph.D. Research Guide.

The Standing Committee of the Academic Council resolved to increase the Honorarium from Rs. 1000/- to Rs. 2000/- per examiner/External Experts and increase the processing fee from Rs. 3000/- to Rs. 5000/- per application for seeking Recognition as Teacher (PG, M.Phil and Ph.D. Degree).

It was also decided to review the rates for Processing Fee/Payment of Honorarium every three years.
