	However, based on the Curriculum & Credit Framework for PG Programmes released by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi dated 14 June 2024, the following points under Eligibility Criteria are to be modified:
	(a) The eligibility criteria for admission to the first year of the Master of Engineering Degree shall be as per AICTE Guidelines, Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or equivalent as prescribed by the concerned Board of Studies and approved by the Academic Council. If the eligibility degree of the student is not listed in the list approved by the Board of Studies for admission to the given Master of Engineering Degree Programme, then the student shall have to qualify in the national level or University level entrance examination for the respective Master of Engineering Degree Programme.
	(c) The students who have passed the Post Graduate Engineering Certificate shall be eligible for admission to the second year of the Master of Engineering Programme in the relevant branch/discipline, subject to the availability of seats based on the notification issued by the Government of Goa/ Goa University from time to time.
	Thereafter, the Vice-Chancellor was authorised to approve the same, in view of the urgency.

D 10.3	Board of Studies in Zoology Meeting - Syllabus of B.Sc. Zoology Semester III to Semester VIII Prof. Bernard Rodrigues informed the House that the Academic Council in its meeting held on 10 th and 11 th May 2024 approved the syllabus of B.Sc. Zoology Semester III and VIII with suggestions.

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Thereafter, the syllabus with changes was submitted by the Chairperson, Board of Studies on 16.05.2024, including the syllabus of Semesters I and II which was approved in 2023. The Academic Division on 27th May 2024, notified the syllabus (Semester I to VIII) based on the submission made by the Chairperson on 16th May 2024.

It was brought to the notice of the House that a practical component (1 Credit) has been included in a Minor Course ZOO-111 (Understanding Applications of Zoology) offered in Semester I and II. However, the Guidelines issued by the University prescribed that only Programmes offered under Science Discipline shall be permitted to offer 1 Credit Practical Component for Major 1 Course. There was no mention of any changes suggested to Semester I and II courses in the Board of Studies submission. However, due to oversight, this was not observed before circulation.

After detailed discussion, the Standing Committee of the Academic Council resolved to issue a corrigendum to the concerned School/Colleges informing that the syllabus shall be revised and the practical component shall be dropped.
