### **Revised Minutes of the First Meeting of the XI Academic Council**

Date: 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2024

Time: 10.00 a.m.

A list of members who attended the First Meeting of the XI Academic Council and those who sought leave of absence is appended.

The Chairperson (Vice-Chancellor) welcomed the members to the First meeting of the XI Academic Council, especially the external members of the House and informed that, besides the Ex-Officio members, the Academic Council is represented by University Professors, Principals of Affiliated Colleges, University Teachers, Representative of SC/ST Category, Elected Members, and five External Members who are the Nominees of the Honourable Chancellor whose term is of two years. The Chairperson introduced the External members who have excelled in their respective fields, Shri Damodar Mauzo, Dr. Srinivasa Kumar T., Dr. K. N. Madhusudanan Pillai, Sr. Prof. (Dr.) A. M. Unnikrishnan and Dr. Suresh Babu.

The Chairperson (Vice-Chancellor) informed the members that the University has implemented the New Education Policy for Post Graduate General Education Programmes from 2022 onwards and Under Graduate General Education Programmes from 2023 onwards and General Sciences offered at the University Campus and Affiliated Colleges. From the current academic year New Education Policy for Engineering Programmes will be implemented.

The Member Secretary (Registrar) informed the House that as per the practice the notice of the meeting of this Council would be sent one month in advance subsequently and the agenda will be sent electronically to all the members, fifteen days before the meeting. The final agenda would be sent not less than five clear days before the meeting. Table agenda would be avoided unless it is very much essential. The Member Secretary (Registrar) informed the house that the University has received "Show Notice cum Demand Notice issued under the provisions of Section 74 read with Section 122 of the Central Goods & Services Tax Act, 2017" from the Office of the Commissioner of CGST & Central Excise, Panjim regarding Non-Payment of GST dues by Goa University on affiliation and recognition fees as well as other fees like sports, examination and tuition fees received from various Colleges for the period 2017-18 to 2023-24. The GST dues amounting to Rs.4,83,59,747/- crores have been claimed by the GST Office.

It was further informed that the affiliation fees for the above period were collected without GST. Hence, as per the notice from Commissioners Office, University will be required to collect the GST @18% from the affiliated Colleges/Institutions towards the affiliation fees paid by them for the period from 2017-18 to 2024-25 (till date).

The Academic Council was informed that the request shall be forwarded to the Office of the Chief Minister, Goa and the GST Council to waive off the 18% GST on items like affiliation fees, examination fees, tuition fees etc.
