Mr. Balachandra B. Jadar, Assistant Director of Physical Education & Sports, Goa University informed on the following to the House.

The Academic Council was informed that Mr. Aayush Gadekar, student of D. M's College and Research Centre, Assagao, had participated as a Unified player in the Special Olympics World Summer Games 2023 held at Germany from 17.06.2023 to 25.06.2023.

Further, it was informed that the said student was not eligible for the award of Sports Marks for participation in the championship as per the pre-revised OA-26 that was in force during his participation period.

Ordinance OA-26 has been amended with effect from 29.08.2024 and the new provisions make a student eligible for the award of Sports Marks for participation as a Unified player in the Special Olympics World Summer Games under Category A2.

Considering the above, the Academic Council decided to apply the said amendment to the students from 2023-2024 onwards. Also, the Academic Council considered the case of Mr. Aayush Gadekar and decided to award Sports Marks for his participation as a Unified player in the Special Olympics World Summer Games 2023 held in Germany from 17.06.2023 to 25.06.2023.
