The Chairperson (Vice-Chancellor) welcomed the members to the Fifth (Special) meeting of the XI Academic Council.

It was announced that the Self-Study Report (SSR) of Goa University submitted to the NAAC on 1st April 2025, has been accepted. The clarifications sought by NAAC were duly addressed through the responses to the DVV (Data Validation and Verification) queries. The University is now awaiting confirmation of the final dates for the NAAC Peer Team Visit, which are expected shortly. As per the revised NAAC Guidelines, the Peer Team visit will be conducted in hybrid mode, involving both online and on-site interactions. The University has initiated all necessary preparations in this regard.

The Chairperson (Vice-Chancellor) on behalf of the Academic Council also thanked all the Chairpersons, Board of Studies for working meticulously to recommend the syllabus as per the new UGC Guidelines.
