1. Goa University proudly announces that it has been accredited with an A+ Grade and a CGPA of 3.30/4.0 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its 4<sup>th</sup> accreditation cycle which is valid up to July 2030. This achievement marks a significant leap from the previous B++ Grade and this is the highest ever grade achieved in the history of Goa University.

The A+ Grade reflects the University's sustained commitment to academic excellence, research advancement, quality infrastructure, and student-centric initiatives. This milestone was made possible through the collective efforts of the teaching and non-teaching staff, students, alumni, and the unwavering support of the State Government.
