3. Mr. Naik, learned advocate for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the petition on the ground that cause of action no more survives.

4. Though this petition was filed as Public Interest Litigation, considering the statement made by Mr. Salkar, learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of State Government, we deem it appropriate to permit Mr. Naik to withdraw the petition since the cause of action no more survives.

5. In so far as the Judgment and order dated 6/7/2006 passed by respondent no. 2 is concerned, the parties are at liberty to avail of appropriate remedy as may be available in law.
