ORAL ORDER

Panaji: 19/01/2011

This Appeal under Section 188 of the Land Revenue Code was directed against the Order of the Dy. Collector in which the Mamlatdar of Tiswadi was directed to mutate the land records in respect of Survey Nos. 228/2, 229/1 & 230/1 in favour of the Government.

2. Learned Advocate Mrs. A. Agni appeared on behalf of the Appellant and Shri E. P. Lobo, Ld. Advocate appeared on behalf of the Respondent before me to-day.

It is contention of Mrs. Agni on behalf of the Appellant that in view of the Report of the Khalap Committee appointed by the Government, there is a Memorandum dated 17/02/2010 of the Dy. Collector, North Goa directing the Mamlatdar of Tiswadi to take action in the matter in view of the said report of the committee headed by Advocate Khalap appointed for the purpose of examining the claim of the University. As per the said report, the survey records of the Survey



Nos.228/1, 229/1 & 230/1 of Tiswadi Taluka are to be re-mutated and the name of the Appellant, Goa University to be entered in the survey records as occupants in place of the Government which was earlier mutated.

The Ld. Advocate for the Appellant has produced on record the Memorandum dated 17/02/2010 issued by the Dy. Collector, Collectorate North Goa to the Mamlatdar of Tiswadi with direction to take necessary action in the matter by referring to the letter dated 13/02/2010 of the Registrar of Goa University and the new I & XIV forms of the said properties surveyed under No.228/1, 229/1 & 230/1 in which the name of Goa University has been recorded as occupant as per the new development in view of the report of the Khalap Committee and of which implementation has been already done by re-mutation and the survey records being corrected accordingly.

On perusal of the documents produced in support of the Memorandum brought on record of this Appeal, Shri E. P. Lobo, Ld. Advocate for the Respondent submitted that this Tribunal, in view of said documents by which the survey records have been corrected by Order of the competent authority, can pass appropriate orders. On perusal of the Memorandum and the survey records which are supported by letters of the Registrar and Dy. Collector, since the Goa University has been already recorded as occupant in the survey records of Nos.228/1, 229/1 & 230/1 which was claim of the University before this Tribunal in the Appeal hereinabove, in my opinion, there is nothing further, to be decided in this Appeal and as such, the same has become infructuous for which it has to be dismissed as infructuous. Hence, Order is hereby passed dismissing the same as infructuous.
