1. The Petitioner herein is a student of Goa Medical College and Hospital, Bambolim, Goa. She had answered her Third Professional (Final Year) MBBS Part II Examination (Supplementary) in the month of April-May 2025, but could not complete the exam due to medical issues that were beyond her control. As such, the Petitioner is seeking one more opportunity to answer the Third Professional (Final Year) MBBS Part II Examination.

2. Ms. Agni, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Respondent No.2, has submitted that taking note of the peculiar facts and



circumstances of the case, the University has decided to give one more opportunity to the Petitioner. However, the exam schedule will be intimated in due course of time so as to enable the Petitioner to prepare herself for the same. Mr. Devidas Pangam, learned Advocate General for the State of Goa, appearing for Respondent Nos. 1, 3 and 4, is present and has supported the stand of the University.

3. If that be so, there is no live issue that calls for adjudication in this petition. The Writ Petition is therefore closed by recording the statement of Ms. Agni, learned Senior Counsel for Respondent No.2.

4. We make it clear that in view of the above submission made by the learned Counsel for the Respondents, none of the issues raised by the Petition, have been considered by this Court on merit and the same are kept open.

5. Writ Petition stands disposed of.

6. Office objections, if any, are waived of.
