



## GOA UNIVERSITY STUDY JAPAN PROGRAMME

### Guidelines to Parents and Students

15<sup>th</sup> December 2014

1. The College of International Relations, Nihon University, Mishima, Japan will be hosting this programme for the PG students of the Goa University from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015. The University can send 10 students for this programme. The Nihon University will charge 1,28,000 yen (details available on the Notification) excluding to and fro air fare. Lectures on the course entitled "Japan: Culture, Society and Business (48 hours) will be delivered.
2. The application has to be submitted in Academic (General) Section on or before 12/01/2015.
3. The applicant has to be present before the screening / selection committee on 19/01/2015 at 3.00 p.m. in the IQAC Hall, administrative Block of the University. In matters of final selection of students, the decision of the Committee appointed for the purpose shall be final.
4. The applicants have to produce their passport on 19/01/2015. In any case passport should be obtained latest by 9/02/2015.
5. The selected students have to deposit Indian rupees equivalent 1,28,000 yen to the Registrar, Goa university through the Academic (General ) Section latest by 23/02/2015 along with necessary documents to obtain visa clearance from Japan.
6. Students have to make their own arrangements to obtain visa from Consulate General of Japan in Mumbai.
7. The purchase of Air tickets to and from Japan will be coordinated by the Office of Academic (General) Section.
8. Soon after obtaining visa and before travelling to Japan the Students have to purchase comprehensive Travel Insurance.
9. Students are required to submit a one page (approximately 500-750 words) write-up along with the form indicating why do they feel encouraged to apply for the programme and what will their expectation be from the same.
