CIRCULAR

Principals/Deans of Colleges affiliated to Goa University are well aware that the University requires the services of the teaching fraternity in the affiliated colleges to conduct its examinations across all faculties, notably for purpose of paper setting and assessment through the Central Assessment Programme (CAP). Cooperation of the teaching fraternity is therefore essential for the University to conduct examinations, complete assessment and declare results as per schedule. However, there have been instances in the past when examination-related assignments have been turned down by teachers, often without due justification, throwing the examination and assessment schedule into disarray, thereby causing avoidable hardships to the Examinations Division of the University.

Attention of the teaching faculty is invited to the statutory provisions of the University as well as to Goa Prevention of Malpractices at University, Board and other Specified Examinations Act (Goa Act No. 8 of 1991), wherein it has been clearly laid down that examinations work is an integral part of a teacher's duty and declining such important tasks shall be viewed seriously and shall also be punishable under the law.

Principals/Deans of affiliated Colleges are, therefore, requested to exhort all teachers in their respective colleges to cooperate with the Examination Division of the University in the conduct of its examinations, central assessment, and timely declaration of results. Any failure on the part of the teachers to perform time-bound examination duties assigned to them shall be viewed seriously, constraining the University to initiate action deemed appropriate under the relevant provisions of the law.
